2027 - THE YEAR OF THE NORMANS, marks the millennium of William the Conqueror's birth

There will be massive international celebrations and the planning has started. We are trying to make sure Norwich is involved in a big way.

As well as Zoom and face to face meetings in Norwich we have had meetings at the British Council in Stratford, London and at the Institut Français in South Kensington, London. Attending the meeting in Stratford were people from Triorca, The Forum, Norwich City Hall, Chris Austin and Marion Catlin.

We also had Prof Trevor Davies for the Climate Change and Art projects which has come from the French visit in 2024 when Gennadij and Trevor explained it all in front of the Norwich Mural for us and our French visitors – Twinning works!

Sadly, Norfolk Museums weren't there or the Cathedral, but people there talked to all about the fabulous possibilities they offer, and we are keeping in contact and encouraging them.

At the Institut Français meeting we met the President of the Normandy Regional Council, M. Hervé Morin, and Ms Catherine Morin-Desailly, French Senator and Chair of the Normandy Regional Council's Culture, Tourism and Heritage Committee. The Triorca team made an excellent impression, and, of course, this should result in a long term sustainable connection which is what we want.

Now we have been tasked to get connections with Norwich junior football, Normandy, Rouen City Hall and clubs in Rouen and Normandy to see if we can have an international tournament in Normandy, for greater numbers of Norwich junior footballers to go to! Places mentioned so far are Norway, Sweden, Ireland, Sicily, and other places where the Normans came from and where they went!

Also being suggested are Folk dancing, choirs, orchestras, pétanque! We need partners in Rouen and Normandy to propose these and organise them!
